The product packaging includes a USB Bluetooth dongle, but if your computer was made after 2010, it should include built-in Bluetooth. This scanner can scan barcodes from a computer screen. The factory settings include a CR (carriage return) suffix and is set to HID mode for use with BrokerForce®.

Bluetooth Pair the Scanner

- 1) Press the button to turn on the scanner and scan the "Bluetooth mode" barcode to convert scanner to Bluetooth mode
- 2) Scan the "Match" barcode. The flashing blue light indicates that the device is in matching (pairing) mode.
- 3) On the PC, open Control Panel, click "Add a device", the computer will search for available devices
- 4) Click on "General Bluetooth HID Barcode" and click <Next>, the computer will automatically install the driver
- 5) When connected, the blue light is normally on and the device will beep twice.
